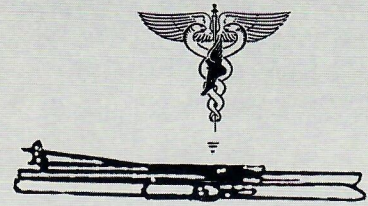

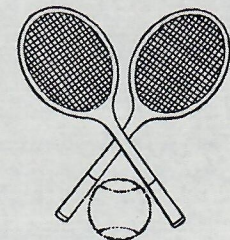

SKI DESK UPDATE

For those of you who have been following the trip news from this columnist all year, well, take heart! I will now give you the status of all the trips, now that we have survived the first meeting SIGN-UP MANIA!

Each year the VP-Trips looks into the SCSC Crystal Ball and tries to plan the trips based on all the available feedback from the members who skied with us last year. The Texas Ski Council trips continue to be our best selling trips. And in an effort to keep our trips as competitively priced as possible, we added more seats to these trips this year. The status of the TSC trips follows:

- **Copper Mountain** - Full with a wait list
- **Winter Park** - (week trips) 37 seats available
(short trip) Full with a wait list
- **Keystone** - 4 seats available
- **Banff** - Full with a LONG wait list

We are investigating the possibility of adding seating to the Banff trip, but have found the best air fare at this time to be approximately \$100 more than our current trips. We have not been able to secure lodging at this point (EVERYTHING, even in town, is booked!). If you are hoping to go on the Banff trip, I would suggest that you check your spot on the wait list and depending on how many other SCSCers are ahead of you, sign up for the Traditional Texas Ski Week.

We will begin to cancel the unsold seats for Winter Park after the October meeting. We have to start putting cold, hard cash on the line well in advance of the actual trip dates, so DON'T DELAY!

As for the rest of the SCSC trips, here is their status:

- **Park City** - ONE seat left - HURRY, we don't expect it to last!!
- **Aspen** - Twelve seats available. We will cancel seats after the October meeting based on our cash commitments that are due.
- **Switzerland** - Plenty of space available. You will not find a cheaper trip to Switzerland for a week. I hope you read the article TC Shirley Andries wrote in this issue.

If we do not see more interest in this trip, we will cancel it after the October meeting.

- **Breckenridge** - Ten seats available.
- **Purgatory** - Twenty-three seats available.

If you missed the September meeting, call the TC of the trip that you want to go on and SIGN UP as soon as possible. If you are on a wait list, the TC will call you as people cancel off the trip. In the meantime, have your alternate trip choices in mind.

And as a final note, I don't want anyone of you to think that your VP-Trips and the DOTs don't practice what they preach!! We'll all be a part of one of the TSC trips and plan to help bring home the TEXAS SKI CUP this year. Look for Cheryl Clements on Winter Park; I'll be on Keystone and Ray Naudain will be on Banff. (Unfortunately, Ms. Holder and her better-half Tom Mercer blew all their vacation in Europe this summer and for the first time in five years will be absent from the TSC Fall Roundup trip. But we'll be there in spirit!!)

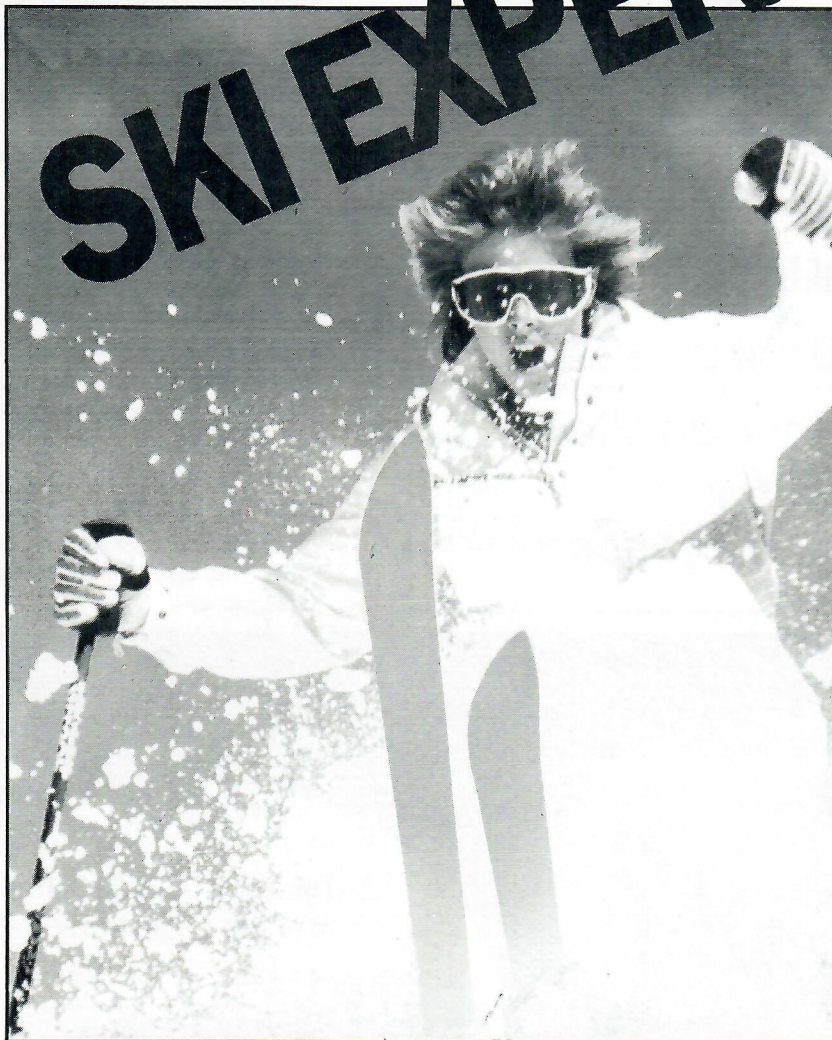

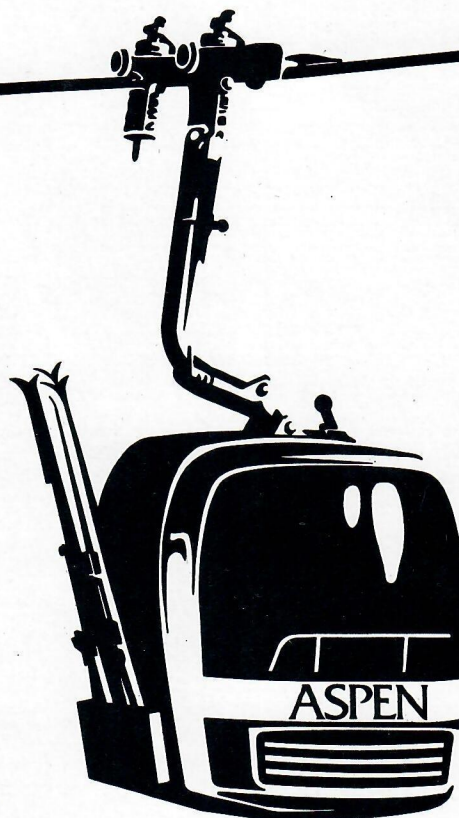

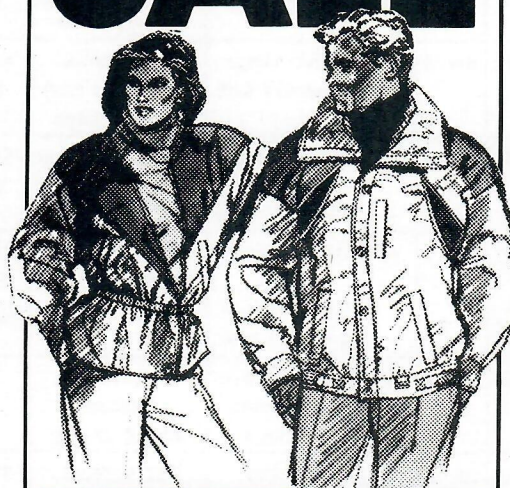
