SUMMER PICNIC

This year the SCSC's summer party will be at there HOUSTON YACHT CLUB on Saturday, August 22, 1970. Party activities begin at 2:00 P.M. – that is when the Port Hole Bar opens – and will last until late in the evening. A complete bar-be-que chicken dinner, topped with watermellon for desert, will be served at 7:00 P.M., on the lawn east of the Teen Room, that is, on the shady side of the building.

Keg beer will flow all afternoon. Soft drinks and cocktails will be served in the Port Hole Bar – downstairs on the west side near the pool – throughout the afternoon and evening. There is no charge for beer and soft drinks, but you must purchase chit books, at a nominal fee, to obtain mixed alcoholic beverages. Unused drink chits will be refunded.


We are hoping for good breezes so we can take advantage of the sailing facilities. There will be several Sunfish (rigged up) for those who are already sailors. For the Land-lubbers there will be a number of boats with experienced skippers to take you for rides. We have plans for several Hobie Cats, a couple of Dragons and perhaps some larger cruisers.

Those of you who have your own boats, be sure to bring them, as a ramp and two cranes are available for launching. Remember the more boats, the more fun for all. Power boats as well as sailboats will be great fun for skiing or just scooting around, especially if the breezes are light.

Since it is a private club our activities will be limited to the first floor facilities and grounds. These include the Port Hole Bar, the Teen Room with ping pong and jukebox, the dressing rooms, and swimming pool. We expect to see volley balls and everpresent frisbees flying through the air. Be sure to bring bathing suits or a change of clothes if you plan to indulge in the water sports.
