B. Layout

Page Make-up

The SITZMARKE continues a magazine format. The pages are printed in column form on 8½ x 11" enamel glossy offset paper.

Headline Legibility

The Masthead and the article titles are set in bold Bodoni type. Article copy is set in caps and lowercase, complimentary Optima type, using italics or bold face matching type for highlights. Reverses are purposely used for titles in order to draw the reader's attention. The margins of the individual ski trips are bordered in bold reverse type. The trips are outlined in black to accent each one.

The post trip articles repeat the margined format, but replace the reverse type "Ski Trips 1973-1974" with the specific trip taken.
