

To get to the Atascocita Country Club, get on the Eastex Freeway, Highway 59, by turning north on Chartres from Pease, Jefferson, Calhoun, Pierce, the Gulf Freeway feeders and drive in a northerly direction for approximately 19 miles to the Humble cutoff. Turn right off the freeway and go thru Humble to the Humble-Atascocita Road, FM 1960. Travel East approximately 6 miles until you come to Atascocita road that intersects from the right. Bear

left for 2 miles and the picnic area will be on the right just before crossing the McKay bridge going over Lake Houston. For those that want to play golf, turn left into the Atascocita Club area. There are also boat launching ramps on that side. There is also a fishing camp with a concrete launching rampif you go straight ahead at the intersection of FM 1960 and Atascocita Road.
