SUBJECT: Balance due-----\$95

A balance of \$95 is due now for the New Years Vail Trip. If this balance has not been paid by November 20, 1967, your place on the trip will be given to the first one of the waiting list and your initial deposit will be refunded.

The trip will leave Hobby Airport via Braniff #164 departing at 6:00 p.m., Wednesday, December 27. We will arrive in Denver at 10:06 p.m. where we will board chartered buses for Vail. We should arrive in Vail at approximately 1:30 a.m.


We will depart Vail on Monday, January 1, 1968, at 4:00 p.m. for Denver where we will board Braniff #177 at 8:00 p.m. At Dallas we will change to flight #549 and should arrive in Houston at 1:30 a.m., Tuesday, January 2, 1968.

Travelers Insurance is offering an accident and medical policy covering \$1000 accidental death and \$1000 blanket medical coverage for any treatment necessitated while you are under the policy period beginning at 6:00 p.m. December 27 and ending at 6:00 p.m., January 2, 1968. If you are interested, make out a check to the SPACE CITY SKI CLUB for \$4.86. Please mail your checks to me before December 15, 1967.

For those of you who requested that I rent equipment for you in Vail, I have written all three rentals and should have a confirmation as well as prices at the next meeting, November 20, and will collect at that time your rental fee.
